There will also be speakers throughout the day on CVs, interview techniques and managing your business.

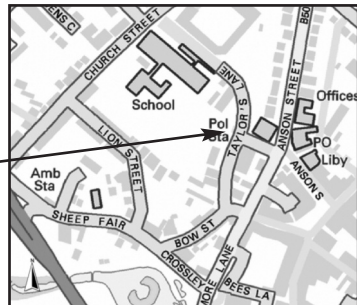
